

ATTENTION LAND PARK NEIGHBORS

On March 17, Fleet Feet will host the 19th Annual Shamrock'n Half Marathon.

Dear Neighbors,

Please be advised that approximately 3,000 runners and walkers will run/walk through the Land Park streets between 8:00 am and 11:30 am on race morning. We cordially invite you to be a part of this event as a participant or a spectator. If you can't join us, for the safety of our participants, we respectfully ask that you avoid driving on your street during this time-period. A map of the course is on the reverse side of this sheet and more information may be found at shamrocknhalf.com. The following areas will be affected on race morning.

1

Area 1

Your area will be affected between 8:00 am to 10:15 am. Riverside Blvd. from The Westin Hotel to 13th Ave. Runners will be on the West Side of the Street. You will be able to head North on Riverside all the way to 13th Ave.

2

Area 2

Your area will be affected between 8:00 am and 11:30 am. We have created an exit plan for you to easily leave your neighborhood. Please follow the detour signs that will take you from 13th Ave. to W. Land Park Dr. to 15th Ave. and then out to Land Park Dr. to Sutterville Rd.

Your area will be affected between 8:30 am and 11:30 am. Please avoid driving during this time frame. If you must drive, consider parking your vehicle east of Govan Way ahead of time to exit Land Park Dr. north. If you live on Swanston Dr., Regina Way, 13th Street or 4th Ave., consider parking your vehicle north of Vallejo Way to exit toward Broadway.

Area 4

Your area will be affected between 8:30 am and 11:30 am. Please avoid driving during this time frame. If you must drive, please use Santa Buena Way to 8th Ave. across Riverside Blvd. to Teneighth Way and then Land Park Dr. north (after am)

Area 5

Your area will be affected between 8:30 am and 11:30 am. You may exit right onto 5th Street to Vallejo Way and then right on to Muir Way.

Area 6

Your area will be affected between 8:30 am and 11:45 am. Please avoid driving during this time frame. If you must drive, we have worked it out with the Sacramento Police Department for you to exit to 5th Street from Tailoff Lane. Please note that you will only be able to turn left on 5th Street up to Broadway. You will then be directed by police officers to stay to the right of the cones which will be placed on the center lane line separating the event participants from vehicle traffic.
